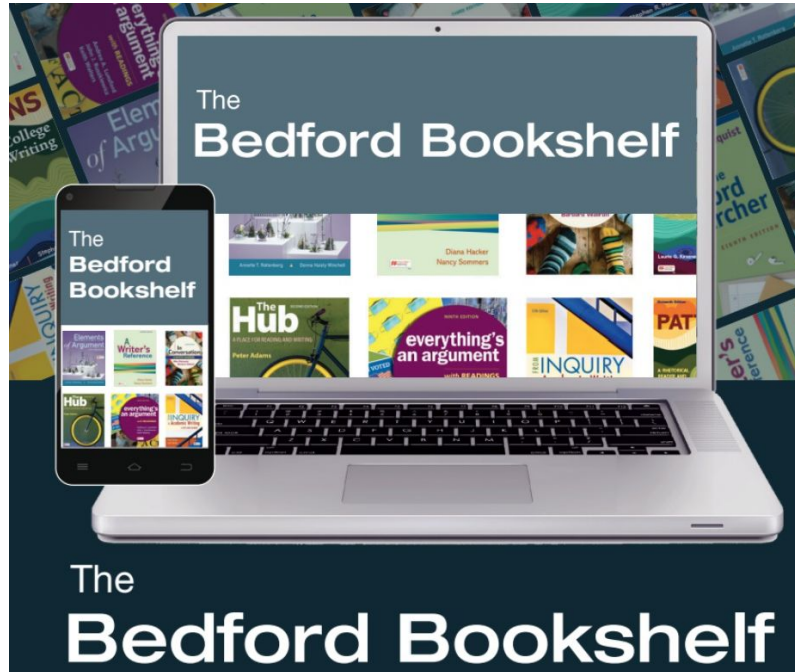

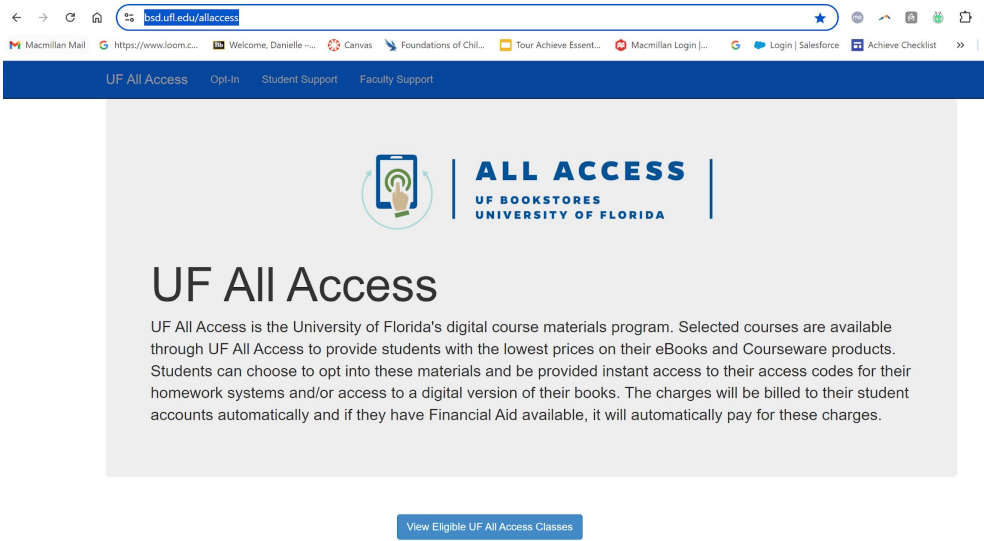

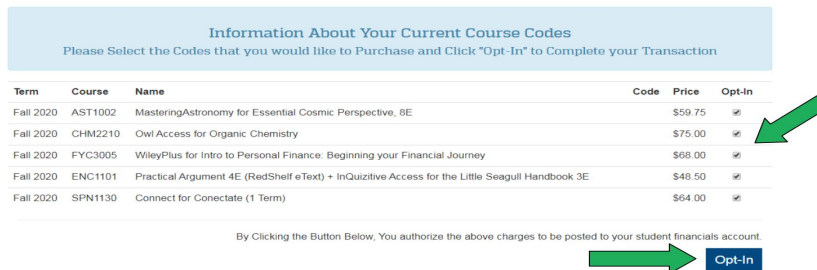


UF All Access

Reading to Write

STEPHEN KING

Born in 1947, Stephen King is a 1970 graduate of the University of Maine. He worked as a janitor in a knitting mill, a laundry worker, and a high school English teacher before he struck it big. Today, many people consider King's name synonymous with horror; he is, beyond dispute, the most successful fiction writer in America. He has written dozens of novel stories, novellas, and screenplays, among other things. His books have sold well over 350 million copies worldwide, and he has been made into popular motion pictures, including *The Green Mile*, and *It*. His fiction, starting with *Salem's Lot* (1975), *The Shining* (1977), *The Dead Zone* (1979), *Pet Sematary* (1983), *The Girl Who Loved Tom Gordon* (1990), *Everything's Eventual: Five Dark Tales* (2002), *11/22/63: A Novel* (2013), *The Boogymen of Bad Dreams* (2015), and (with his son Owen), *Sleeping Beauties* (2017). King's most recent work includes *The Outsider* (2018), *The Institute* (2019), and *If It Bleeds* (2020), a collection of four novellas.
